

2011 AWANA SCHOLARSHIP CAMP INFORMATION

When? July 23-30, 2011 (Saturday 5:00 pm to Saturday 9:30 am)
(No evening meal is provided for campers on the Saturday night.)

Where? Camp Tulahead, north of Princeton, BC (Use your favourite map program for location)

Who? T&T and TREK (campers entering Grade 6 - 8)
High School JOURNEY (campers entering Grade 9 - Grads)

What? Exciting activities include water front (water sports, swimming, canoeing, kayaking), field and court games, Bible class, special "evening fun activities," evening chapel, crafts
All campers will be asked to complete memory verses each day of camp.

How?

Camper Eligibility:

- Priority will be given to British Columbia clubbers.
- First time campers: must have completed at least two Awana handbooks (grade 3-grade 12 age-appropriate material*)
- Returning Campers: must have completed age-appropriate handbook(s)* since attendance at Scholarship Camp. *For high school campers - one main study *and* one elective
- 11 years of age** by first day of camp *and* entering grade six through graduation

- Cost: \$70 Registration Fee (Non-Refundable) plus \$225 Camp Fee

Total Camp Fees: \$295 due at time of application.

(may be the entire amount in one cheque or a deposit of \$70 or more with a separate check which may be postdated up to June 10 for balance up to \$225.00)
