IT'S SUPPOSED TO BE ON FIRE.

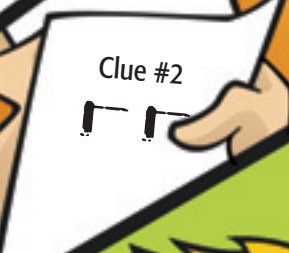
